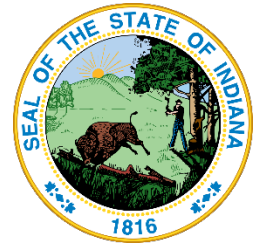

To better assist the Primary Next of Kin (PKON) in selecting the appropriate type of honor guard for their loved ones, please read the following explanations below.

- Full Honors** Pallbearers, colors flight, firing party, armed escort, taps and flag presentation.
- 2-Man** Flag-folding, taps, and flag presentation.
- Full Cremation** One man carries a folded flag, a second carries the urn, firing party, taps, and flag presentation.
- 2-Man Cremation** Flag-folding, taps, and flag presentation.

I have been briefed on the type of military honors that will be received for my request and furthermore understand that the United States Veteran Reserve Corps will select the composition of the Honor Guard teams, which may reflect the diversity of the U.S. VRC ranks in terms of gender, race, ethnicity, or faith..

All requests should be made as soon as possible, but no later than 48 hours in advance.
